

SCRIP \$\$\$ for Cardinal Ritter and You!

Groceries, Gasoline, Birthdays, Christmas, Eating Out, or Home Improvements; wouldn't it be nice to get an extra discount on all of these expenses! Cardinal Ritter participates in the SCRIP program. The word SCRIP is a term meaning "substitute money". It is a simple way for YOU, along with Cardinal Ritter, to earn money. SCRIP is also a great way to purchase necessities and gifts without paying the extra dollars most fundraisers require.

Here's how it works:

- You stop by the school, phone, email, or send with your student cash, check, or charge card information (made payable to Cardinal Ritter High School) for the face value of the gift cards being ordered. Orders are handled by Tara Rembusch in the main office.
- Cash & Carry SCRIP stocks about 40 retailers in various amounts. If a retailer that you are interested in is not listed on our order form, simply go to www.glscrip.com, click on "retailers" on the tool bar and write them in on your order form. This order will be sent in with other CRHS orders that are not stocked in Cash & Carry and returned to you in about a week. Your order can be returned to you through your student or you can pick it up in the school office.
- Earnings from the SCRIP works like this: Cardinal Ritter purchases gift cards from the Great Lakes SCRIP Center at a discount for as high as 25%. This discount can add up to lots of earned money for CRHS and YOU! 50% of the discount is credited directly to Cardinal Ritter. The other 50% is credited to your name and a running account is kept throughout the year. This can then be applied to any Cardinal Ritter fund of your choice or a student's tuition for the next school year. You will be asked towards the end of the school year where you want your share to be applied.
